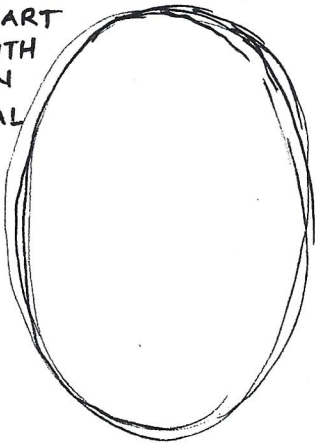

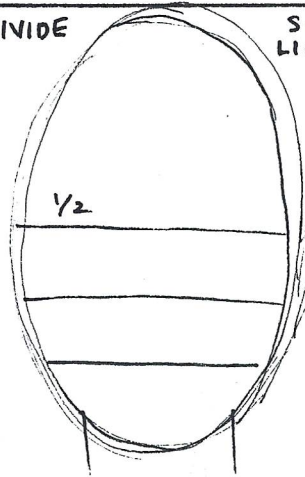

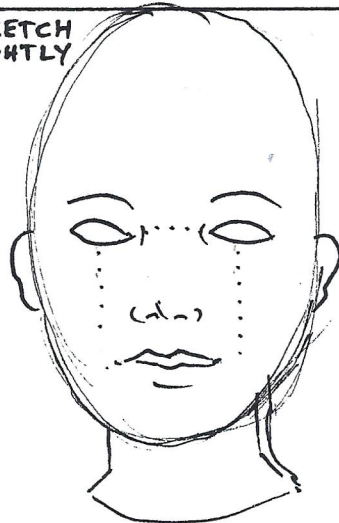
START WITH AN OVAL



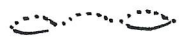
DIVIDE



SKETCH LIGHTLY



The SPACE BETWEEN EYES IS ABOUT 1 EYE LENGTH



DRAW LINES FROM THE MIDDLE OF THE EYES TO SHOW WHERE THE MOUTH IS.



FACES CAN BE OVAL-SHAPED, CIRCULAR OR SQUARISH

EARS are as unique as fingerprints!

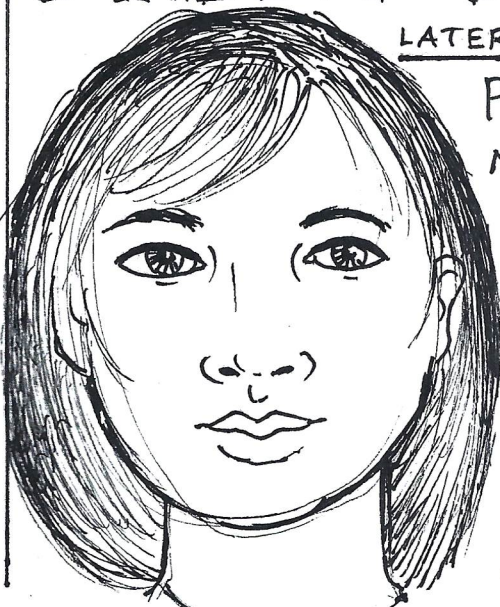
DIVIDE THE SHAPE 1/2, then DIVIDE the LOWER PART 1/2 WAY, AND AGAIN IN 1/2. THESE ARE APPROXIMATE MEASUREMENTS.

EARS ARE LOCATED BETWEEN THE GUIDELINES for the EYES & NOSE

SOME SIMPLE NOSES: ~ (d o)

## DRAW LIGHTLY at FIRST

LATER ERASE the EXTRA LINES
