Trees are wonderful subjects to draw. They do not complain about staying still for a long time. They don't mind any mistakes you make when trying to capture their image on paper. **TWO MAIN POINTS** to remember: trunks are solidly rooted in the ground & branches get thinner as they grow out from the trunk.

There are over 60,000 tree species. Notice the different textures of bark. Try to capture the shadows as well as the tree. You can draw the same tree at various times of day (& eventually all the seasons too - and weather.
